次の文章を読み、設問に答えなさい。

Ken and Emi are at the school festival at Nagano Nishi High School.

(HS=a high school student)

**Ken:** Look! There are a lot of people over there. What are they doing? Let's go there.

(at a \*food drive \*booth)

**Emi:** Excuse me. What are you doing?

**HS:** We're \*working on a \*project called ①a food drive.

**Ken:** A food drive?

**HS:** It's an \*activity to collect \*surplus food at home or food that can still be eaten but is \*disposed of for \*various reasons, and give it to the people who need food. The food here will be given to people like that in Japan.

**Emi:** I thought that people like that are only in \*developing countries!

**HS:** I used to have the same idea as you, but I read in the newspaper that one in seven children in Japan is living in \*poverty. When we were thinking about what we could do to help them, we \*came to know about this activity.

**Ken:** Over there, the students are collecting children's clothes, aren't they? Are ②they going to be given to children in Japan, too?

**HS:** That's another project called \*the Power of Clothing. It is run by UNHCR and UNIQLO. Children's clothes that are \*no longer \*worn are collected and given to ③\*refugees who need clothes.

**Emi:** \*I've heard of refugees, but \*I'm not sure what they are.

**HS:** Refugees are people who have to leave their countries for various reasons. One \*major reason is \*conflicts. It is said that there are 82.4 million refugees in the world today, and about \*half of them are children.

**Ken:** I have a lot of children's clothes that I no longer wear. The school festival ends tomorrow, right? I'll bring my clothes.

**Emi:** I'll check if there's any surplus food at home and bring it here, too.
